Understanding Communication

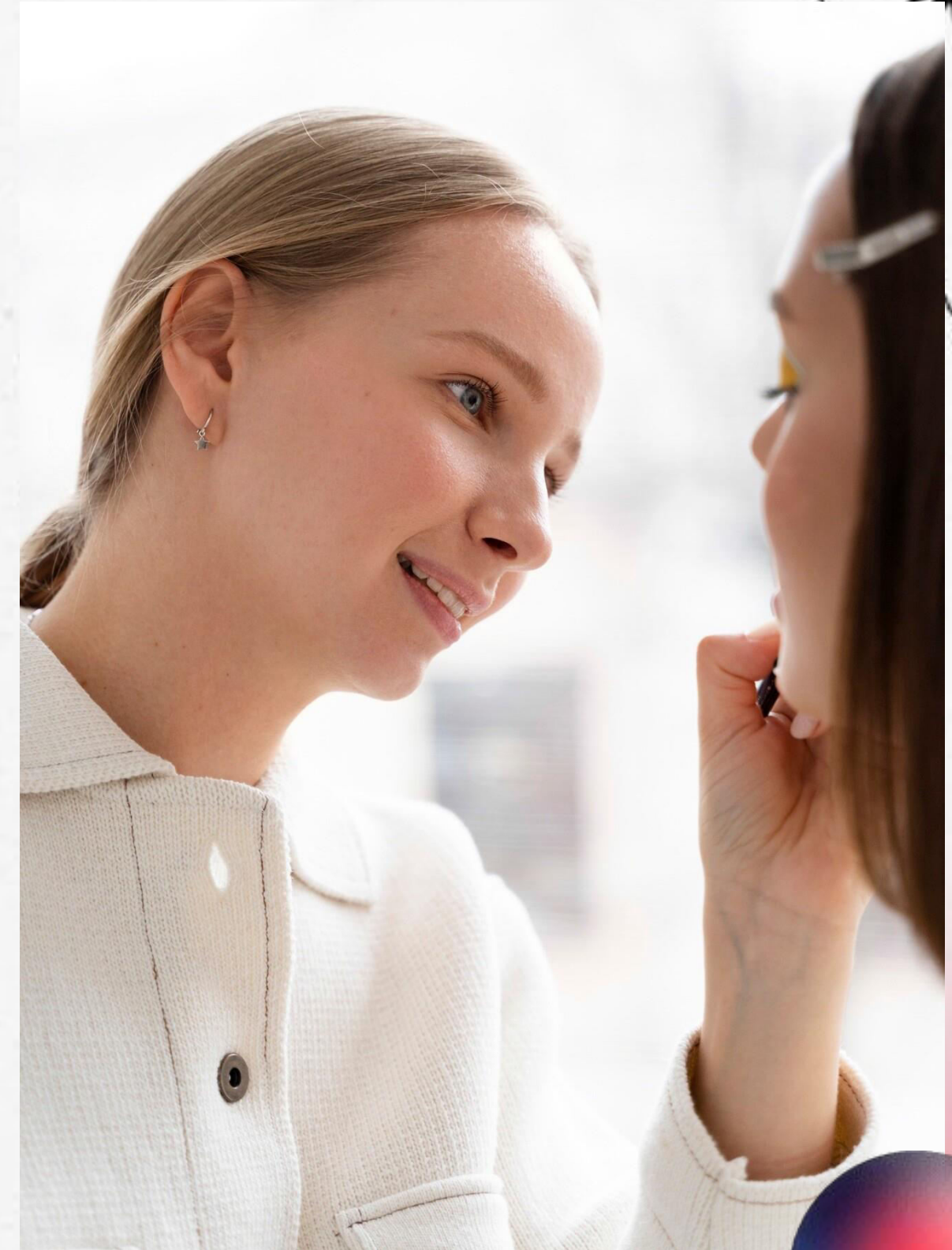

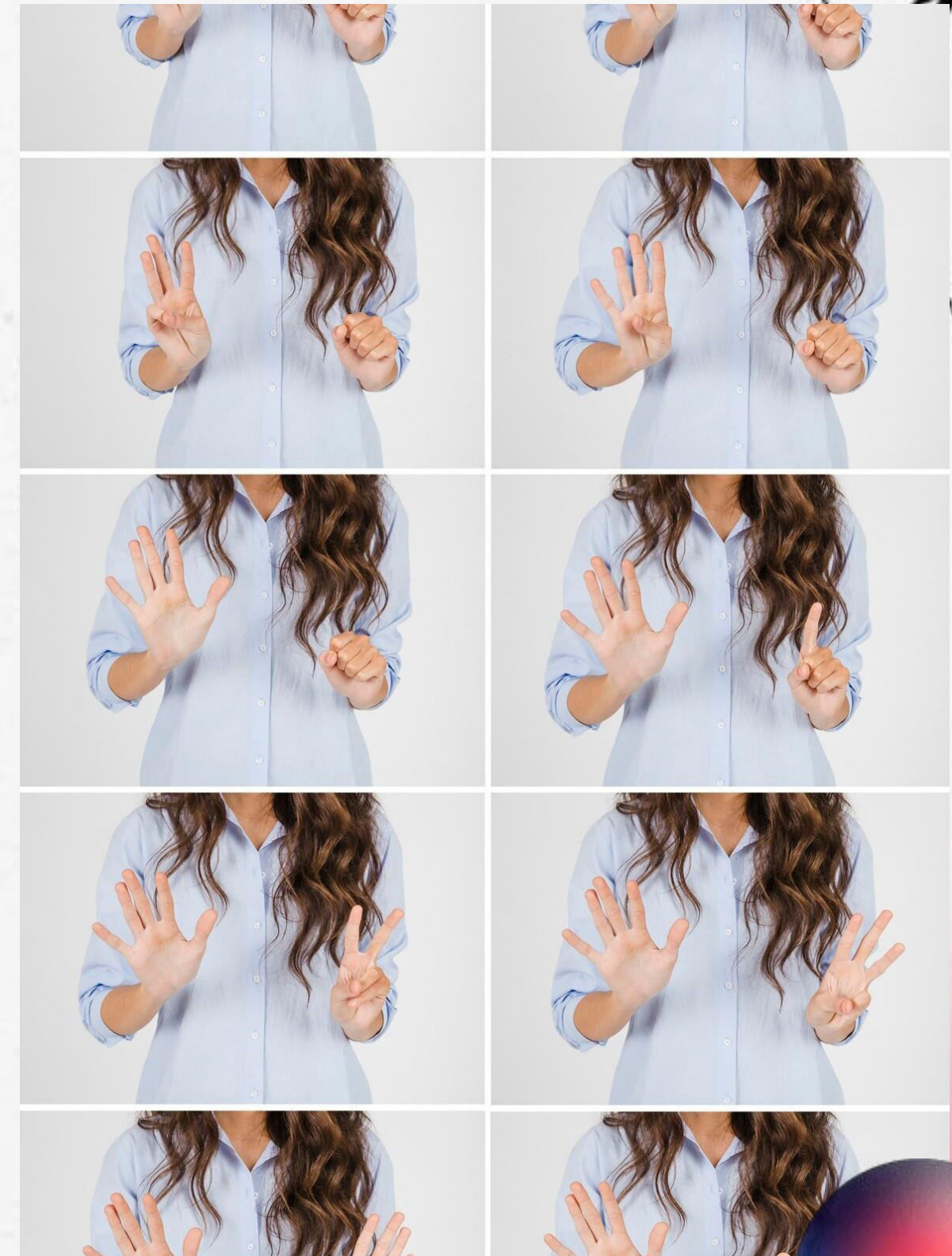

These practices create a positive atmosphere that encourages open and honest dialogue.


